Board Meeting
November 18, 2014**

The police officer assigned to report at this meeting was unable to attend due to an arrest.

Jeanne Dorman updated us on her Riverside Trail project to construct a walking path along Riverside Drive. She is working with the City Trails Coordinator. Most property owners along the path have been receptive. The city will determine shortly if an engineering study is required for erosion issues. Jeanne doesn't need anything from the SCA at this time.

John Cardwell reported that our bank balance for September was \$4138. We had \$185 in renewals or new memberships. There was also a newsletter add for \$125. YTD we have taken in approximately \$2600. The SCA had receipts of \$5500 in 2013 and \$5200 in 2012.

Officer elections were held for 2015. Doug Cooke was elected Vice President, Jean-Marie Hay was elected Secretary and Steve Price was elected Treasurer.

Committee charters, goals and budgets were tentatively approved for 2015. If receipts continue at 2014 levels, budgets will be reduced accordingly.

Ralph White requested the City Services committee contact the DPW to repaint the crosswalk at the intersection of Hathaway and Shawnee. City Services will also follow up with the DPW on curbs, gutters and potential sidewalk for Cherokee Road.
