Board Meeting
March 18, 2014

The board discussed the need for a financial audit and will make a formal decision next month. We need to identify qualified residents to help us conduct it.

The SCA will sponsor a Clean-Up on April 5th rain or shine from 9:00-11:00 AM. Focus areas include: the Forest Hill / Chippenham interchange, Jones & Jones property and areas along Riverside Drive. We will meet at the SRC and break into groups. Prince will get gloves, trash bags, grabbers and vests from Darlene Mallory with the Dept. of Public Works

Jeanne Dorman gave an update on her Riverside Trail project and asked for the SCA's support. The board agreed to provide initial support for the approach outlined in Jeanne's presentation (voluntary – property owners can opt out, still in discovery phase, need input from city lawyers on liability and Chesapeake Bay act compliance, costs & budget established, and city's willingness to maintain the trail long term). Jeanne agreed to provide us with regular updates. The board will define the SCA's long term support as the project evolves and is fully defined.

We need to advise Tim Grimes if additional signage is needed at the roundabout at the eastern section of Riverside & Rockfalls. The city is NOT putting in the roundabout on the western section of Rockfalls & Riverside due to drainage issues.

We discussed ways to stop speeding on Riverside Drive. Tim Grimes suggested posting "\$250 Additional Fine for Speeding" signs as a deterrent. He is also going to ask for increased police surveillance for Riverside Drive.

Steve Prince will serve as Secretary for 2014. Brian will be contacting all board members to fill the open slots for the City Services & Development and Membership committees. We need 3-4 board members or interested residents to staff each committee. The Communications committee is adequately staffed.
